## Divisions

**Intro Rider**—rider who has never completed Hopeful level at any Horse Trial

**Intro Horse** —horse that has not completed Hopeful level at any Horse Trial

**Hopeful Rider**—rider that has never completed Beginner Novice at any Horse Trial

**Hopeful Horse** — horse that has never completed Beginner Novice at any Horse Trial

**Beginner Novice Rider** — limited to rider that has not completed a USEA Horse Trial at Novice Level

**Beginner Novice Horse** — limited to horse that has not completed a USEA Horse Trial at Novice Level

**Novice Rider:** The competitor may not have completed more than two Horse Trials at the Training Level or higher within the previous 24 months

**Open Novice.** The competitor may have completed more than two Horse Trials at the Training Level or higher within the previous 24 months
