



FRC Scholarship Application

Eligibility & Requirements:

Four scholarships are available annually; two in the spring (Jan thru June), two in the fall (July thru Aug), amounts up to \$500.00 each. In order to qualify for scholarship consideration the following criteria must be met:

You must be a current FRC member in good standing.

Scholarship must be used for a specific horse related educational or competition purpose. Examples include, but are not limited to: clinics, educational seminars, workshops, continuing education, regional or national championships, selection trials, etc.

Scholarship recipient must give back to FRC in some tangible way. Examples include, but are not limited to: article(s) for the newsletter & website, talk at a monthly meeting, volunteer at least 8 hours (or the equivalent of one day) at a FRC function within a year of receiving the scholarship, etc. - use your imagination!

Scholarship monies are NOT to be used for meals, travel or hotel expenses.

Scholarship monies may NOT be used for regular lessons, shows, personal vacations.

If the event is cancelled or you cannot attend for any reason, or the program is not completed, all scholarship monies must be refunded to FRC.

If there are multiple applicants in a calendar year, volunteer service to the club in the current and preceding membership year(s) will be taken into account in awarding scholarships.

How It Works:

For events taking place January 1 thru June 30, applications are due no later than January 1st.

For events taking place July thru December 31, applications are due no later than July 1st.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance after review by the FRC Board, including a letter of agreement to be signed stating timeframe for use of money & expected contributions to FRC.
